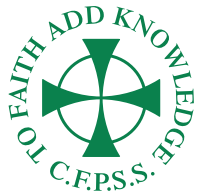

Inasmuch as the Fellowship is a Christian Fellowship, membership is open to those who satisfy the Council that they are members of a recognised Christian denomination, or are sympathetic to the Christian faith and willing to accept this pre-eminent ethos of the Fellowship.

The CFPSS operates at a local, regional and national level. It provides fellowship and opportunities to share and study at residential and one-day conferences, as well as at group and branch meetings. The Fellowship publishes two journals, *The Christian Parapsychologist* and *The Fellowship Review*, which are sent free to all members.
